WEATHER: Weather was not too good, not too bad. Sometimes too much of sunny weather disturbed bird activities but overall the weather was okay.




- RED PANDA SIGHTING IN TWO CONSEQUITIVE DAYS

Third day morning started with a sighting of gorgeous Crimson breasted woodpecker, followed by a glimpse of Slender-billed scimitar babbler, late morning we got a pair of beautiful Darjeeling Woodpecker. We also got some other birds like Yellow-bellied fairy fantail, Streak-breasted scimitar babbler, Black-faced laughingthrush etc.





Fourth day started with elusive satyr tragopan followed by two skulkers Rufous throated wren babbler, scaly-breasted cupwing, broad-billed warbler, We also got to see golden breasted fulvetta, brown-parrotbill, yellow-browed tit and other commoners.

Fifth day we went to higher reaches for birding and sixth day after having bit of birding at lower reaches we finished our tour. Highlights of this two days birding are 20to25 individuals Fulvous Parrotbill, Yellow-rumped honeyguide, White-browed bush robin, Hodgson's and rusty flanked tree-creeper, Eurasian Nutcracker, Green-shrike babbler with many commoners.
